Information SAL S20 AMS

- The S20 SALs have been distributed on October 31, 2019.
- As of November 1, 2019, season S20 is accessible in <u>www.e-Airportslots.aero</u> in read only for the airports AMS, RTM and EIN. The portal is not available for coordination for S20.
- ACNL received requests from the bankruptcy administrators of the airlines Jet Airways (9W) and Adria
 Airways (JP) to reserve slots for season S20 pending a formal takeover of the airline's activities. In line with
 article 8.15.2 and 8.15.3 of the Worldwide Slot Guidelines, ACNL conditionally allocated slots S20 to these
 airlines subject to further investigations. ACNL is in close contact with the administrators of these airlines
 to stay informed about the progress of the bankruptcy proceedings.

AMS Capacity Declaration W19 - Planning limit/Operational limit

- ACNL is requested to take into account an Operational Limit in allocation of slots after HBD. Since the
 Operational Limit is 192.551 (i.e. lower than the Planning Limit of 193.810), allocation of slots in case of
 handback -if any- can only take place after the number of allocated slots drops below the Operational
 Limit.

Amsterdam Airport Schiphol Local Rule 2

- The Minister of Infrastructure and Water Management approved "Schiphol Local Rule 2" as of 31 August 2019. Schiphol Local Rule 2 applies from IATA-season W19 up to and including S21.
- Schiphol Local Rule 2 as well as a working procedure can be downloaded from www.slotcoordination.nl/slot-allocation/local-rules.

Guidance for Force Majeure requests

- ACNL published the Guidance for Force Majeure requests which gives airlines clarity on how to submit a request for Force Majeure; examples of Force Majeure; and Proof of Force Majeure.

Resume Monitoring RTM as from IATA W19

• To ensure the optimal use of the scarce capacity and the available infrastructure at Rotterdam The Hague Airport ACNL will resume monitoring activities at RTM. ACNL will resume monitoring of NOOPS/NORECS at RTM as from start IATA W19.

Transition policy

- Due to a court decision on the capacity declaration during S18 (transfer of unused winter), a surplus of
 historic slots compared to available capacity has originated. ACNL respected these historic slots, resulting
 in a surplus of allocated slots compared to the available capacity in S19.
- Currently, ACNL is in the process of developing a transition policy on the manner in which the number of slots will be equal to the available capacity. The CCN has been informed about this.
- As part of this, ACNL cannot allocate new slots from the waitlist until handback causes the number of allocated slots to be less than the Planning Limit/Operational Limit (whichever is effective).



New organisation ACNL and slot fee

- Dutch Parliament passed a law to transform ACNL from a foundation into an independent governing body by public law. The formal transformation will take place in April 2020.
- Simultaneously, a system of slot service fees will be introduced which means that air carriers will have to
 pay a tariff per landing and take-off. At this moment, the level of the slot service fee is yet unknown. The
 expectation is that the airport managing body will collect the fee using the billing system in place to collect
 other airport charges.

Lelystad Airport (LEY)

- The European Commission has adopted a positive decision on the Traffic Distribution Rule (TDR), which was proposed by the Minister of Infrastructure and Water Management. Aim of the TDR is to move, on a voluntary basis, certain categories of flights from Schiphol to Lelystad Airport.
- The Minister of Infrastructure and Water Management did not announce an opening date for Lelystad Airport (LEY) yet. ACNL expects that, upon opening, LEY will be a slot coordinated/Level 3 airport and ACNL will be appointed as slot coordinator.
- Meanwhile, ACNL is in close contact with the Ministry to discuss the implementation of the TDR and in
 particular the role of ACNL. ACNL will publish more information on www.slotcoordination.nl once
 available.

EURO2020

- ACNL has been in close contact with the Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management and Royal Schiphol Group on the EURO2020 subject.
- As discussed during the CCN meeting of August 29, 2019, according to the Ministry and ACNL the current slot allocation process based on EU Slotregulation 95/93 and the available capacity as declared in the "capacity declarations" of the slot-coordinated airports of Schiphol, Eindhoven and Rotterdam are leading.
- No additional capacity and/or specific procedures are foreseen.
- ACNL will publish an update on <u>www.slotcoordination.nl</u> should this situation change.
