

Updates Airport Coordination Netherlands (ACNL) for IATA SC153 DXB

Reduction movements Amsterdam Airport Schiphol (AMS) S24

- Earlier announced Experimental Decree for reduction maximum number of commercial movements has been paused by the Dutch Government.
- Airlines will be notified about an updated reduction task shortly after Amsterdam Airport Schiphol has amended the capacity for S24. The amendment to the capacity declaration will be consulted in the Coordination Committee Netherlands.

SALs S24 AMS, EIN, RTM

- The S24 SALs have been distributed on 2 November 2023.
- AMS SAL for S24 may include code T (instead of K). Airline portfolios to be confirmed after fulfillment of reduction task before HBD 31 January 2024.
- S24 for Dutch level 3 airports accessible in <u>www.e-Airportslots.aero</u> in read only.
