



Updates Airport Coordination Netherlands (ACNL) for IATA SC156 YVR v1.0

NATO Summit June 2025

- On 24 & 25 June 2025, the Netherlands will host the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Summit.
- Capacity reductions are in force at AMS during the period: 21 June 21:00 until 27 June 2025 08:59 (UTC).
- ACNL will apply JNUS for cancellations during this period. JNUS applications must be submitted to: monitoring@slotcoordination.nl

SALs W25 AMS, EIN, RTM

- The S25 SALs for EIN & RTM have been distributed on 2 June 2025.
- The S25 SAL for AMS has been distributed on 3 June 2025, in conformity with the revised environmental capacity (see below). Airlines that are affected by the reductions were informed by ACNL at SAL and will be contacted about the next steps.

Revised environmental limit Amsterdam Airport Schiphol (AMS)

- Following the Balanced Approach procedure, the Dutch Ministry of Infrastructure & Water Management decided on an environmental limit of 478.000 commercial aviation movements per operational year including a maximum of 27.000 night movements at AMS effective as of W25: <https://www.rijksoverheid.nl/documenten/kamerstukken/2025/05/07/versneld-lvb-schiphol> (Dutch only).
